BS – No Teaching Experience

Hold A BS degree with no teaching experience. Working toward an A initial license

Transcript Evaluation to see if additional content courses or cut score on PRAXIS II is needed

3.0 GPA at the undergraduate level.

Typical program will be 24 hours and include a 6 hour student teaching experience.

Complete program in 4 semesters. Grad Certificate awarded. Recommended for a CLEAR level A . 18 hours may count toward a Masters degree.

BS – Provisional/Restricted License/Lateral Entry – with 3.0

Hold a BS degree and have been hired on provisional/restricted teaching license. Working toward an A Level Restricted License

If you have a 3.0 GPA, apply for the GRAD CERTIFICATE
Take 19 hours through the GRAD CERTIFICATE ONLINE.

Complete program in 3 semesters. Grad Certificate awarded. Recommended for a CLEAR level A .
18 hours may count toward a Masters degree.
